NOTICE OF SOLICITATION OF GENERAL CONTRACTORS & MWBE
PARTICIPATON FOR VARIOUS
COMMERCIAL BUILDING RENOVATION PROJECT ON JEFFERSON AVENUE
IN THE CITY OF BUFFALO, ERIE COUNTY, NEW YORK

The East Side Commercial District Program (ESCDP) is providing funding the Owner of 261 East Ferry for a building addition and façade improvements by one general contract for construction for each building. The contract for construction for 261 East Ferry – Solo Eats will be the AIA A133-2019 Between Owner and Construction Manager as Constructor.

The ESCDP grant is administered by the state agency Empire State Development Corporation (ESD) and the local Citizen's Alliance / Black Chamber of Commerce (CA/BCC). They encourage participation of designated Minority- and Women-owned Business Enterprises in State-funded projects. The Contractor, by bidding on the contract, acknowledges understanding and support of this policy and pledges to fully cooperate with ESD and CA/BCC to provide MWBE firm participation. The State of New York Dept. of Labor Prevailing Wage Rate Schedule **DOES NOT** apply to this project.

CBCA is sub-contracted by ESD to provide Design Concept Documents for each building project. Effective June 2, 2021, the documents may be purchased and/or examined free of charge at online plan rooms: Construction Exchange of Buffalo & WNY (conexbuff.com); Avalon (www.avalonbuff/plan); or the NYS Contract Reporter (www.nyscr.ny.gov). Sets of the Design Concept Documents may be purchased from the Construction Exchange and Avalon.

There will be a Pre-Bid Meeting for 251 East Ferry – Solo Eats on Friday June 11, 2021 at 11am. All bidders are encouraged to attend and COVID19 Safety protocols will be followed with Masks required and physical distancing.
